

Using FTP with Internet Explorer 7 Client

- Go to <http://www.acitexas.com> and click on the ftp link at the bottom of the page.
- Enter the User Name and Password that was given under the project description.
- Once the ftp site opens, click on the "Page" Button, then click "Open FTP Site in Windows Explorer"
- Enter the User Name and Password again
- Drag the folders you would like to download to your desktop, DO NOT TRY TO OPEN THEM DIRECTLY FROM THE FTP SITE.
- Troubleshooting:
 - Double Check User Name and Password
 - Verify IE7 is set to Passive FTP Mode (Click on Tools, Internet Options, Advanced, Use Passive FTP should be check)
 - Check with your IT Dept to make sure they allow FTP through their firewall
 - Try a different FTP Client Software

Using FTP with Internet Explorer 6 Client

- Go to <http://www.acitexas.com> and click on the ftp link at the bottom of the page.
- Enter the User Name and Password that was given under the project description.
- Once the ftp site opens, click on the "Page" Button, then click "Open FTP Site in Windows Explorer"
- Enter the User Name and Password again

Using FTP with Firefox 2 and FireFTP Add-on

*****Using Firefox without the FireFTP add-on is not recommended. You will not be able to download multiple files.**

- Open Firefox, Click on Tools, Click on FireFTP
- Click on create an account
 - Account Name: Enter the name of the American Constructors Project
 - Host: <ftp.acitexas.com>
 - Login: the User Name provided to you
 - Password: the Password provided to you
 - Click OK, Click Connect
- Select on the files you would like to download on the right
- Select a destination folder on the left
- Click on the "Left" (Download) button to download

Using FTP with Mac OSX with ClientFTP

*****Using FTP on Mac OSC without the ClassicFTP is not recommended. You will not be able to download multiple files.**

- Apple Classic FTP can be downloaded at http://www.apple.com/downloads/macosx/internet_utilities/classicftpformac.html
- Open ClassicFTP, Click on the Sites Button, Click Add Site
 - Label: Enter the name of the American Constructors Project
 - FTP Server: <ftp.acitexas.com>
 - User Name: the User Name provided to you
 - Password: the Password provided to you
 - Click OK, Click Close, Click Connect, Click on the American Constructors site in the dropdown
- Select on the files you would like to download on the right
- Select a destination folder on the left
- Click on the "Left" (Download) button to download
